

# San Lorenzo del Escorial



## What to see:

El Escorial is famous for its beautiful *Monasterio* which was built between 1563 and 1584. We recommend going inside the monastery, even though the entrance fee costs €10.

Once you've visited the monument, it's absolutely necessary to take a walk around the charming little town. Grab a seat at a *terrazza* and enjoy the pure air of the city's mountains, known as *la sierra de Madrid*.

## How to get there:

- **By cercanías train ([map](#))**

**Depart from:** Sol, take Cercanías Line C3

**Schedule:**

Departure ([Horario Sol-El Escorial](#))

Return ([Horario El Escorial-Sol](#))

**Duration:** approx. 1 hour

**Price:** 5,40€ (round trip 10,80€). Buy tickets from machines inside Sol's train station.

*\*Note: you will have to walk 15 min or take another bus to get to the center.*

**Depart from:** Moncloa, take bus line 661

**Schedule:**

Bus line [664](#) (every 10-15 min)

**Duration:** approx. 1 hour

**Price:** 4,20€ (round trip 8,40€). Buy tickets on the bus.
