# San Lorenzo del Escorial



### What to see:

El Escorial is famous for its beautiful *Monasterio* which was built between 1563 and 1584. We recommend going inside the monastery, even though the entrance fee costs €10.

Once you've visited the monument, it's absolutely necessary to take a walk around the charming little town. Grab a seat at a *terraza* and enjoy the pure air of the city's mountains, known as *la sierra de Madrid*.

# How to get there:

By cercanías train (map)

Depart from: Sol, take Cercanías Line C3

Schedule:

Departure (<u>Horario Sol-El Escorial</u>)
Return (Horario El Escorial-Sol)

**Duration:** approx. 1 hour

Price: 5,40€ (round trip 10,80€). Buy tickets from

machines inside Sol's train station.

\*Note: you will have to walk 15 min or take another bus to get to the center.

Depart from: Moncloa, take bus line 661

Schedule:

Bus line <u>661</u> (every 10-15 min) Bus line <u>664</u> (every 10-15 min)

**Duration:** approx. 1 hour

**Price:** 4,20€ (round trip 8,40€). Buy tickets on the bus.
